Dear Mr. Swartz:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) for release of information from the files of the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command (USACIDC) pertaining to Bradley Manning. Your request was referred from Department of the Army, Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall and was received at this headquarters on March 15, 2011.

A search of the USACIDC file indexes revealed that an active investigation is in progress with an undetermined completion date. You may submit another written request for a copy of the investigation at a later date, after it is completed. You may consider this an initial denial of your request pursuant to Title 5, USC, Section 552a, Exemption (j)(2) of the Privacy Act and Title 5, USC, Section 552, Exemption (b)(7)(A), (b)(2), (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of the Freedom of Information Act.

This response is made on behalf of Brigadier General Colleen L. McGuire, Commander, USACIDC, the Initial Denial Authority for USACIDC records under the FOIA, and may be appealed to the Secretary of the Army.

If you decide to appeal at this time, your appeal must be submitted within 60 days of the date of this letter. In your appeal, you must state the basis for your disagreement with our response. Your appeal is made through this Center and should be addressed to the Director, U.S. Army Crime Records Center, FA11-1810, 6010 6th Street, Fort Belvoir, Virginia 22060-5585, for forwarding, as appropriate, to the Office of the Secretary of the Army, the appellate authority. An appeal may not include a request for additional information or a request for an investigation to be conducted.
